Minutes of inaugural meeting of the above council held on Tuesday
19th April 1977 in Kemnay Scholl.

The meeting opened with speeches of good wishes from Councillor R.Reid
and Major Fyffe. Mr. F.Lloyd on behalf of the Chief Executive of
Gordon District Council then proceeded with the business of the
evening and the election of office bearers.

Chairman. Mr. L.McKay, proposed by J.Seton and seconded by H.Hughes.

Vice Chairman. Mr. B.Innes, proposed by J.Seton, seconded by M.Wainman.

Secretary/Treasurer to be a joint post at first. Mrs M.Morris.
proposed by W.Duncan, seconded by C.Marshall.

The appointment of auditors was deferred to a future meeting.

A detailed study of the document, a scheme for the establishment of
community councils took place and after discussion it was decided
that the subject of a constitution will be deferred for a while.
It was decided that the Community council No. 6 (Kemnay) will
be known as KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL. Mr. Lloyd agreed to enquire
into the dates required for A.G.M.'s and audited accounts as it
appears from the scheme that we are limited to a date at the end of
November or thereabouts.

It was decided to open a bank account at the Clydesdale Bank Ltd.,
Kemnay to be operated in the name of the council by the three
office bearers.

Both Regional and district councillors will forward a list of their
respective council and committee meetings.

Mr. J.Seton raised the question of Kemnay Community Association and
it was felt that the office bearers of the community council should
meet with their counterparts in the community association to sort
out areas of reference.

A question was asked about the second Garmoch Academy and Major Fyffe
promised a complete update for the next meeting.
