MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON JUNE 26th 1980 at 7.30pm IN KEMNAY SCHOOL

The minutes of the meeting held on Thursday May 29th were adopted as a true record, proposed by Mr Wainman seconded by Mr Cumming.

Matters arising

Notice Board Mr Bailey proposed that we accept lowest offer if still open, seconded by Mr McKay. Secretary to negotiate with Kemnay Community Association and Kemnay Public Hall Trust committee. Also contact Mr Cruickshank, then go ahead.

Swings at Alehousewells Leave until Region has money for soft landing.

Litter Bins in Park Mr Bailey observed that a larger more substantial bin would be needed when the pavilion was complete. There was also a need for one in the children's play area. It was hoped that the new ones would be permanently installed. Councillor Reid promised to deal with this and added that Mr McKinnon was doing his best.

Councillor McLean said that there would be a divisional roads meeting before the end of July and he would raise the matter of the island of shrubs outside Kemnay School which was obscuring vision towards Monymusk. It was also suggested that that the Horner 'layby' be tidied up.

Academy Playing fields The secretary was instructed to write again pressing for the 'Natural barrier' between the playing field and river to be integral part of development and not dependant on money available.

Burnhervie Bridge Councillor McLean reported that this might be 9 months and a major construction.

Pavilion in Park There was much concern over delay in building and why our questions through Councillor Reid were offensive to Mr Kennedy.

Paradise Road Mr Bailey reported flooding in new bungalows which was worse since the Fraser Plce/ Paradise Road junction had been improved. Councillor McLean to view.

Planning applications Canine enterprises, application for houses to replace factory. Councillor Reid assured Dr Hern that if it was not in the terms of the Draft Plan it would be turned down. Mrs Innes thought that traffic generated by housing might be preferable to that by the present factory. After a vote 5/5 it was decided not to comment at the moment.

Elections The Secretary was asked to write and keep up the pressure to have voting for elections held in the Public Hall rather than at Kemnay School.

Disabled Year. 1981 Mrs Forbes reported from the Meeting in Inverurie and volunteered to sit on the committee. She thought the aim was to be educative rather than fund raising. Proposed Mr Bailey, seconded Mr McKay.
