Opportunity to withdraw names . fifteen or less - no election

MINUTE OF MEETING HELD IN KEMNAY SCHOOL ON THURSDAY 26th NOVEMBER 1981 at 7.30pm

1. The Minute of the meeting held in Kemnay School on Thursday 29th October was accepted as a true record, proposed by Mr Cobb, seconded by Mr Cumming.

2. Matters arising

a. A 96 Road junction to Airport

Letter received from Mr Turner, Director of Grampian Region Roads Dept. It was noted that alteration to junction was in progress at the moment

b. Kemnay Green

A site meeting had been held today and it was hoped that progress would be made in better drainage.

c. Shrub Island out side Kemnay School

There had been agreement with the Region to replant with low growing plants to aid visibility.

d. Kendal Road

Roses had been pruned and beds tidied,

e. Park Pavilion

Work progressing inside

Sporting Club committee had met and a meeting would be arranged with Gordon District Officials on management.

f. Polling for general election - use of Public Hall rather than school

Letter received from Mr McNaughton, Grampian Region, Position to be reviewed after Regional Council election May 1982

3. Correspondence received

a. Letter from Kintore Community Council suggesting contact between all community councils in Gordon District. It was agreed to contact other councils to see if there was a need on mutual concerns. Regional councillors McLean & Sorrie to liaise on water problem.

b. Letter from Ann Landels, Carlioch Centre on Capital Grants to Voluntary Youth and Community Organisations, discontinuance of scheme, particularly in regard to Hall improvement grants. It was agreed to write objecting to the change in procedure which would put village halls at a disadvantage. Considerable regret was expressed that the opportunity had not been taken to expand and improve the Kemnay Public Hall to accommodate the expansion of the village population. There was also discussion on the increase of commercial usage of the Hall

c. Letter from Ordnance Survey stating that charges for reproduction of street plans would alter at 31st December 1981

d. Letter from Gordon District on draft rules & regulations on Church yards, still circulating for comment.

4. Church Clock

The repaired damage to the clock face shows as conflicting lines when illuminated at night. Solution to be sought.

5. War Memorial

It was brought to the notice of the council that the War memorial was in need of cleaning. Enquiries would be made to see where the responsibility lay for this.

6. Community Council election 1982

Draft approved for procedure. Dr Hern to compose paragraph for inclusion in February Edition of Newsletter. Public Hall to be booked provisionally for election on Thursday April 8th 1982  
Nomination form to be included in February Newsletter.

7. Solvent abuse  
Much concern was expressed that incidents had occurred in Kemnay. Members considered that there should be constructive preventative measures, , beat policing of the village, and enquiries would be made for advice on preventative procedures and help.

8. Gordon District Council - secret talks

It was agreed to write to the District Council to express disquiet at the report in the Press & Journal that a motion had been carried to exclude the press and public from discussion on the 'five year general services capital plan'.

It was considered to be in opposition to 'open government', autocratic conduct in handling public funds.

Dr Hern thought that the possibility of being misquoted seemed a grossly inadequate and bad reason for not holding the meeting in public.

The next meeting of the council was fixed for January 28th 1982 and Mrs Milton, the Chairman wished all members the compliments of the Festive season.
