Although some alteration is now being made to this junction the cause of accidents, in the opinion of the coincil still exists. ie the view of drivers turning right out of the Airport road towards Inverurie , of the traffic going straight from Abardeen to Inverurie, is obscured by traffic waiting to turn into the Airport road. Mr McLean agreed to persue the matter A new point was raised by Mr Wainman. Centre of the road markings had not been renewed when the surface was relaid on Tyrebagger hill last year. This caused a problem particularly in the dark and bad waether. Councillor MoLean agreed to investigate.
