

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON
THURSDAY 29th SEPTEMBER 1994**

1. Mrs Milton welcomed everyone, especially Mr and Mrs Stewart and PC Lamont. The apologies were read.
2. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Mr Pashley said that with regard to item 10 the sum should be £200 instead of £400. Adoption was proposed by Mrs Wainman, seconded by Mr Wainman. Passed no dissent.
3. Matters arising:-
 - (a) **Glasgow Milestones Project.** Dr Piggins read a letter dated 26th July regarding this. The matter to be left in abeyance for the time being. Mrs Wainman reported that PC Shand had found a sculptor who might be interested if the matter were to proceed.
 - (b) **Toilets in Aquithie Road.** After a period of a few days during which the man tasked with the closure had been subjected to such verbal abuse he refused to carry on, the toilets have since been closed at 6 p.m. Cllr Elrick had intimated that she wished them to remain closed, as did the Police. After discussion it was decided that they should remain closed in the evenings.
 - (c) **Dog Signs on the Village Green.** A letter from Gordon District explaining why they were not in a position to fulfil our request for further signs was read. AGENDA ITEM - next meeting - specify designated dog-walking area and ascertain whether or not there is a problem. Letter to be sent to Gordon District asking for the up-to-date position re dog-walking areas.
 - (d) **Roof of Police Station Garage.** Mr Evans reported that the plans had specified grey corrugated sheeting to match the Police Station. However the materials used seemed to be off-white. The matter could be raised with the Planning Department on the grounds that the colour is not as specified. Perhaps it could be painted with masonry paint to correspond to the materials specified in the plans.
4. **Unfinished Business.** Mr Wainman queried the up-to-date position with regard to the closure of Kingseat Hospital.
5. **Correspondence.** LETTER from Gordon Environmental Forum re keeping the "fresh" water unpolluted. LETTER from Association of Scottish Community Councils re renewal of membership - after discussion it was decided not to renew. LETTER from Grampian Region re Structure Plan Addendum 2 - A further 100 houses are planned for Kemnay up to 2001 and another 100 houses between 2001 and 2006. There is no proposal to provide a new secondary school in Kintore although 700 houses in total are proposed. Cllr Hunter said there is spare capacity at Alehousewells Primary School but not at Kemnay Primary.
