KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

Minutes of meeting held on ~~November~~ 1977 in Kennay School.

Minutes of the meeting of 25th October were passed by Mr. W. Duncan.

Business arising.

It was reported that Messrs Barratts Developments had been granted permission for the Parkhill scheme as it stood. It was agreed that a letter should be sent to the Chief Executive regarding the explosive magazine at Craigmyle, Kennay to ensure that the minimal amount of explosive was kept in Kennay.

Aberdeeh Structure plan. A report was given on the initial meeting for Community Councils. A further meeting would be held on 20th Dec. It was decided that the Community Council would arrange a public meeting to follow after the caravan exhibition in Kennay on 14th Feb. and we would try to get a representative from Grampian Physical Planning to attend and answer questions. A booking was taken for the public hall.

Policing. A letter was read from the Chief Constable, and it was agreed that a further letter should be sent to him, impressing that there was no criticism of the local policeman but we still wanted to know the Chief Constable's short and long term plans for Kennay.

A letter was read regarding Road works.

Bring of children to Inverurie Academy. This matter had been raised at School Council and Mr Reid agreed to raise it as Accident prevention. A further letter was to be sent to Grampian Regional Council requesting that spot checks should be made over a longer period than one day and that it should not take place on Fridays or public examination times. Also why did Grampian Regional Council only provide the minimum requirements under law for transport. A letter was also to be sent to M.P. requesting a change in law.

New business.

Procedure for bringing a matter onto the agenda for Community Council. The Chairman did not want to see the Community Council to become the whipping boy, it was still necessary for the individual to play his part and if he received no success then to enlist the help of the Council. It was decided that this could not be enforced but each Community councillor was urged to get the fullest possible background details before putting a matter on the Agenda.

Offensive Trades Acts. The Secretary reported that a letter had been sent to Gordon District Council regarding Canine Enterprises Ltd applications under this Act. Use of Open space at Paradise Road and Fraser Place. A letter was read from residents in the area requesting the use of this open space as a play area for small children if it could be safely fenced. It was agreed to put the matter to Gordon District C.

Use of cars in Leschangie Road beside Kennay pleasure park. Discussion took place on this matter but the fact that parking was allowed on the opposite side of the road increased the danger hazard. It was agreed to ask Grampian R.C. for their Treasurers report. The Council had received £127.52p. from Gordon District Council and £100.00 from Grampian regional Council. The Council then went over their projected expenditure especially regarding the Aberdeen Structure plan. It was agreed to purchase a copy of the Consultation document for every councillor and one copy of the Document plus its appendices for reference.

The Chairman suggested that the Secretary should receive an Honorarium for the work involved and this was agreed. The sum of £50.00p was set for the year 1977-1978 to be paid before the end of the current financial year.

The cost of producing the Kennay newsletter by Kennay Community Association was raised. 1500 copies are circulated each issue and as the Community council is a contributor it was agreed to supply the cost of three reams of paper each issue which will cover the space used by the Council.

It was pointed out that the next standing meeting of the Council was 31st January 1978 and it was agreed that any business arising in the meantime would be dealt with by the Chairman.
