Minutes of meeting held on 3rd May 1978, in Kennay School at 7.30p.m.

The minutes of the previous meeting were passed by P.Shanks and S.Milton.

Business arising

Questionnaire. It was reported that copies were now being placed in each household and arrangements were made for collecting same.

Meeting with Chief Executive, Gordon District. It was agreed that the office bearers should try to find a mutual time to meet with Mr. Kennedy during the school holidays which would allow a longer time.

Beautiful village. Kennay Gardening club had refused to associated with this venture this year and it was agreed that this event should be planned over a year long basis and that a notice would be placed in the next newsletter to arouse interest in such a scheme.

Mr. McKay extended a very warm welcome to Mr. K.Beaumont, Director of Consumer Protection, Grampian Regional Council who explained the functions of his department and the setting up on the Consumer Advisory Service. He also explained the voluntary Village link scheme that is being set up in Kennay by Mrs. E.Gordon, Graystones, Kennay. He answered questions from members and was cordially thanked for attending our meeting.

Recreational facilities. A letter was read from Gordon District Council asking for a list of priorities for facilities. It was agreed to invite all organisations to put forward their proposals for the next meeting. It was also agreed to get a list of existing facilities from Grampian Regional Council. A Schools Council meeting is to be held to review the plans of the new academy and it is hoped to send a similar deputation to last year.

Constitution. Members received copies which will receive technical correction only at the next meeting.

Social Services meeting in Academy on June 10th. Members notice was drawn to this meeting.

A letter was read from Mr. McLean regarding a presentation to Major Fyfe, Mr. Hughes agreed to be our link but it was emphasised that any presentation would be made on a private and individual basis.

Community Council funds. The treasurer reported that Gordon District Council had already sent their payment and drew the attention of the Councillors to the report that the Regional Council were cutting their payment by £60 per annum. It was agreed that when the money was received the treasurer would correspond with the Region regarding an improvement, if it was found that funds had been used.
