KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

Minutes of meeting held on 7th February 1978 at 7.30p.m. in Kemnay School.

Mr. McKay welcomed Mrs. G.Scott, Director of Planning, Gordon District Council, and a letter of resignation was read from Mr. E.Young. Congratulations were offered to the Hern family on their new addition.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as accurate by J.Hern and M.Wainman.

Business arising.

Aberdeen Structure plan. Mrs Scott pointed out that our area is already covered by the Structure plan and that this has to be incorporated within the Gordon District plan. Obviously the Council would be making comments on strategy B.&D in housing and on the transport strategy. Gordon district plan is for a 5 year period and comment would be required on the following topics. Population, houses, derelict rural houses, industry, should there be direction, can local businessmen be encouraged. H.I.D.B. co-operatives scheme, shopping, travelling subsidies, health and social services, sheltered housing, leisure activities, rights of way, communications, post bus etc, mineral extractions, should areas around Kemnay be judged on their own merit. Discussion took place about the population figures produced for the structure plan pointing out that already the figures were too low. Mrs Scott reported that investigations were under way, although in their infancy, to the purchase of a 5 acre industrial site on the Inverurie side of the Dalmadilly road, on Aquithie Road. Individuals expressed concern at purchasing land when Gordon District council already owned land. Was there a need for such a factory?

Explosive magazine at Craigmyle Kemnay.

The Secretary read letters from Gordon District Council and then reported that the Glasgow Herald had informed us of the true significance of this application. It was agreed that a letter should be sent to the Chief Executive of Gordon District Council deploing the lack of information that we were given and asking for their help in objecting to the granting of the license on 22nd March 1978. A meeting was arranged for 17th Feb, with M.P. and M.Morris and P.Shanks agreed to attend

Open space at Paradise Road and Fraser Place. Letter was read from Gordon District C.

Spill of cars in Leschangie Road. Roads dept, will survey the problem in the summer.

Yellow lines in Kemnay. A report was given on the meeting with the roads dept and the scheme outlined.

Library service. A letter was read regarding the additional opening hours of Kemnay library.

Public noticeboard. It was intimated by Kemnay Community Association that they were in dispute with the suppliers of the noticeboard and had given notice to the firm to remove the noticeboard forthwith.

Housewells school play area. A letter was read requesting our views on the use of house car parking areas for play space for school children during school hours. We agreed providing suitable barriers were erected to stop vehicles entering the area.

Regarding future meetings it was decided to hold the March meeting on 21st March and to make the April meeting on 25th April the A.G.M.

Date of next meeting was set for Tuesday 28th February 1978. 614
