Minutes of meeting held on 21st June 1977 at 7.30p.m. Kemnay School

The Chairman began the meeting by informing the Council that the same rules apply to our meetings as to any other Council meeting, i.e. the public are welcome to attend but cannot take place in the discussions and are excluded from that part of the meeting that the council may wish to take in private session.

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

Business arising.

Second Garioch Academy. The Council were invited to send a delegation to the Schools Council meeting on 22nd June to study the plans of the new academy. Mr. B.Innes and Mrs M.Wainman were elected and discussion then took place on the various items we would like to see in the plans.

Financial statement. The Secretary reported that the sum of £127,52p had been received from Gordon District Council and we were awaiting clarification of the V.A.T. from Customs and Excise.

Noticeboard. Planning permission will be required to put a board on the post office, necessary forms are to hand. As the Community Association now had nowhere to fix their board it was decided to support them in their application to Gordon District Council to erect it in the grounds of Kemnay library.

Litter in the park No communication had been received,

Burials. Certain burials had to be paid for by Social Work Dept. Subject discharged.

Houses at Alehousewells. Letter from Chief Executive was read and noted, it was felt that we must do all in our power to make sure that the estimates for next year did include some maintenance for these houses.

Road from Aquithie. Letter was read and we await further information

Playground facilities at Alehousewells. Major Fyffe had made enquiries and had been assured that facilities will be provided. Mrs Truscott agreed to act as an observer for us on the commencement of work.

Seats in the village. It was agreed that a letter should be sent to the O.A.P. association to ask for their views on the siting of seats in the village.

Barratts Developments, Parkhill. The Secretary gave an outline of the deviations that had been brought to the notice of the Council it was agreed that the planning sub committee should make further investigations and submit a report direct to the Chief Executive.

A.O.C.B.

The Chairman stated that it would be necessary for us to make a constitution and he wished all members to give the matter some consideration.

Road safety. A sub committee of Mr. Carmichael, Mr. Shanks and Mrs Truscott were to make a study of particularly bad places and report to the council.

Dog problem. This matter was to be given time at the next meeting.
