* Many times over the years Kemnay residents have complained to the Community Council about stray dogs . Scotland's 56 local councils are urging the Government to introduce new laws to deal with this problem, and are asking people who share their concern to support them. Their proposals are that :- the licence be increased to £ 9, identification tags to be worn, a ban on dogs in food shops, an offence for dogs to be off the leash on roads and footpaths in built up areas, local authorities to set up ' dog parks' . Would members please discuss this matter with residents and ascertain public opinion with a view to 'lobbying' our Member of Parliament / or not.

1a) Mrs Shrago took the secretary's place in her absence.

1b) Mrs Milton paid tribute to Councillor Reid who died recently.

2) Minutes of last meeting Amendments : -
Councillor McLean asked for the following amendments to be made : -
Paradise Road 3EI to read : - including 6ft for the footpath and
Regional News 7 to read :- to cover two winters not years.
Minutes adopted by Mr Cumming and Seconded by Mr Wozinski.

3) Matters arising from the minutes : -

a) Airport Junction :- Councillor McLean reported that the Department is not in favour of traffic lights at this junction as improvements are planned. Council however will maintain signs and road markings in good condition. Mr Bailey deploras lack of action. Therefore proposed that a letter be sent to Mr Turner also STD showing the Community Councils concern over their decisions. Seconded by Mrs Shrago.

b) Horner Layby :- After reports of dangerous minouvers made at junction , Councillor McLean reports councils suggestions

Mr Bailey will go around and ask residents their coments on this proposal and will report back to Councillor McLean on Monday 28th.

c) GRAIN : - copyhas not yet been read by all members. There is a meeting on 12th March in Huntly.

d) Mr Calder questioned the Treasurers Report over ammounts paid to Kemnay Community Association (Stationary) The fact the ammount was paid in two instalments. 16/8/82 £60 31/12/82 £62.48 and account had not come before the Council to be proposed. Mr Cumming reported he had paid the ammounts due as instructed,when voted treasurer. Mr Calder also questioned the taking of the minutes by members in rotation. However as this question was raised at the last meeting Mr Bailey pointed out that according to KCC Constitution at least two thirds of the full Committee would have to vote to have the question raised again.

a) A Letter from Railways Development Society with a petition to reject any further cuts in our Railway system . A copy of petition to be put in Post Office with Mr Cruikshanks permission so that as many signatures as possible be obtained.
