MINUTES OF KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD IN KEMNAY ACADEMY

7.30 Thursday 24th June, 1982.

2. Minutes of last meeting - Adoption of minutes of K.C.C. Meeting of Thursday 27th May at Kennay Academy , adoption proposed - W.Wainman seconded - D.Bailey.

3. Matters arising -

- a) Boat Croft Development , Second Application . H.Cumming stated that he had again forwarded a Petition from the residents of St Johns Gardens , against access through St Johns Gardens. Acknowledgements of his letter sent with the petition was received from Mr Kennedy of Gordon District. It was agreed that the Secretary write on behalf of K.C.C. to the newsletter supporting the petition.
- b) Newsletter / Contribution by K.C.C. to the Newsletter / H.Cumming moved that the sum of £122.48 be given as a contribution. Seconded by D.Bailey / Carried.
- c) Letter from Mrs Scott , Planning Officer dated 27/5/82 , regarding Local Plan / After discussion it was agreed that our Secretary write Mrs Scott to clarify the statements in her letter.
- d) Regional Councillor McLean informed the meeting that there might be a contribution from the Regional Council to K.C.C. for 1982. Mr McLean will report later.
- e) Railway Bridge / Mr McLean , Regional Councillor , stated that difficulty arose regarding the ownership of a piece of land. Mr McLean also stated that the Bridge was now a Capital Scheme.
- f) The meeting was informed that one way signs have now been erected.
- 4) Lifeboat / Climbing Frame. Mr Cobb stated that the lifeboat was still in very poor condition. Mr Reid , District Councillor stated that the lifeboat had been dealt with , and that a climbing frame had been added to the play area. Mr Reid also stated that when he visited the site the children were well behaved , however he would see that Tech services would take another look at the boat.
- 5) Correspondence / Stray dogs in Kennay. In a letter from Mr Kennedy it was stated that without local Bye-Laws very little action could be taken. Mr Cobb stated that many houses in Kennay had two (2) dogs and one cat. A discussion took place regarding the un-attached dogs.
- 6) Mr B.Wainman spoke about the tree in the park , and referred to previous discussions on the proposed removal of the tree. No reply from Mr Kennedy to date.
- 7) Mr D.Bailey spoke on the Raft Race lack of supervision. Letters to newspapers on this subject read to the meeting. After discussion it was agreed that there should be stricter supervision next year. Mr Wainman suggested we offer to help Organizer next year.

- 8) Mr Cobb took up matter of Sewage Plant / Agreed that the question of pollution be watched in future.
- 9) Mrs Milton stated that there was a great deal of Squalor at Leschangie caused by people living in tents in that area. Mr Reid , District Councillor stated that this matter is now being dealt with.
- 10) Mr Wozinski reported to the meeting that children from the Academy were causing a disturbance in Graigearn Park at lunch - time. After discussion it was agreed that our Secretary take the matter up with the Rector of the Academy. Mrs Milton stated that it would be a help if there were police walking around in Kemnay.
- 11) Mr D.Bailey stated that there were still no Industries moving into the industrial area in Kemnay. It was agreed that the Secretary write.
- 12) Mr Cobb requested that the seat by the River Don , should be bolted down by Gordon District as recommended.
- 13) Mr Cumming took up matter of older children and adults cycling on the pavement in Kemnay.
- 14) Mr Wainman queried about the possibility of Dental services in Kemnay. Mr McLean , Regional Councillor stated he would bring up the matter with the Health Board. Mr Cobb suggested the services of the Dentist visiting the school in Kemnay.
- 15) Mrs Shrago brought up matter of Paradise Road. Mr McLean , Regional Councillor is to deal with the residual sand.
- 16) Mr Wainman asked the members of K.C.C, to support the fencing off a play area in the Glebe. It was agreed that District Council be written giving our support.
- 17) It was agreed that Nominations for new - members to K.C.C. should be completed and forwarded by 25th Sept . 1982.
- 18) Next meeting to be held on Thursday 30th September 1982 , at 7.30 at Kemnay Academy.
