MATTERS ARISING

- a. Information Centre. A letter had been received from the Gordon District saying that there would be no grant for funding the rental.

- c. Play equipment at Glebe. Letter from Gordon District was read and noted. It was agreed to write again suggesting the area be fenced and trusting that objectors were residents of adjoining houses.
- d. 'Robert's Tree. It was agreed to ask the Gordon District Council to consider as suggested in letter.
- e. Library Ground. It was agreed to write and thank Gordon District for tidying up and planting the garden area.
- f. Corsefield Croft. Site of proposed industrial development. Letter received Discussion deferred till next meeting
- g. Craigmile Quarry, application for explosive store. Our letter acknowledged (permission granted 25.8.81)
