

MINUTES OF MEETING OF KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 26TH  
MAY 1994

1. Mrs Milton welcomed everyone especially Dr Robins and PC Lamont and the apologies were read. Mrs Rees-Jenkins had sent a letter of resignation which was also read.

2. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read. There was one slight amendment to the Minutes in that Mr Moss is the Press scrutineer and not the Press Reporter. Mrs Shrago is the Press Reporter and the Minutes were altered accordingly. With no further amendments Mr Wainman proposed adoption; seconded by Mr Evans; passed no dissent.

3. Matters arising:-

(a) Kendall Road Rosebeds. Cllr Hunter said that these will be replanted in due course.

(b) Street Lighting in Dalmadilly. Half of the residents had replied to the questionnaire of whom 9 were in favour and 8 against. This is in the programme to be reviewed in 1996.

(c) The Bank Corner. The Divisional Surveyor says that he cannot see what the problem is but he will monitor the situation and keep the Police informed. Mr Marco suggested metal barriers round the Bank corner and Cllr Hunter to speak to the Divisional Surveyor about this.

d) The 30 mph sign in Criagearn. The Divisional Surveyor says it is in the right place, the Marcos say it is not, so Cllr Hunter to go back to the Divisional Surveyor and he will contact the Marcos to discuss the matter. The Divisional Surveyor is currently contacting the Police about speeding through Craigearn. Black and white reflective posts are to be erected on the bend through Craigearn.

4. Dr Pat Robins then gave a very interesting and informative presentation after which a long discussion ensued. She also said that the Health Board is looking for about 1000 volunteers to help in their Keeping In Touch (KIT) programme. Anyone interested should contact them through the Grampian Health Freeline: 0800 44 00 22. Mrs Milton thanked Dr Robins for coming and giving such an interesting presentation.

5. Unfinished Business. On the 22nd June 1993 we wrote to the Scottish Office about the Electoral Boundaries but have not heard anything. A letter to be written saying that as we have not heard from them we assume that we are to be left as we are.

6. The correspondence was read.

7. New Business. None.

8. District News. None in the absence of Mrs Elrick.

9. Regional News. In addition to the matters covered in item 3 above, Cllr Hunter said that someone had written about the possible resurfacing of Aquithie Road and Station Road. Apparently they were both in this year's budget but because of the frost damage on so many roads this has been put back. With regard to the footpath between Bridge Road and Littlewood Court, a sum has been allocated in this year's budget but of course this has to take into account the needs of the garage proprietor. Cllr Hunter said that there had been a complaint about speeding along Aquithie Road. There can be no traffic calming measures because this is a through road. Mrs Newberry mentioned the open area around Alehousewells Primary School and asked if there could be flashing warning lights. Cllr Hunter said that he did not think this would be possible and Mrs Newberry then asked whether an 20 mph speed limit would be appropriate. Cllr Hunter to speak to the Divisional Surveyor about this.

10. Planning Applications. Mr Evans reported seven in all, two of which were contentious. With regard to the proposal to erect a house at Brownhill Croft, Mr Evans to send a letter objecting to this. There was a discussion about the illuminated sign at the Bowling Club and the proposal to dump fertiliser and sand adjacent to the little storage hut. Mr Evans to investigate.

11. A.O.C.B. None.

12. There being no further business to discuss the meeting ended at 9.45 p.m. The next meeting will be on Thursday 30th June 1994.
