Kemnay Community Council

Minutes of Meeting held on Tuesday, 29th August, 1978 at 7.30p.m. in
Kemnay School.

Present: J. Hern, H. Hughes, B. Innes, M. Morris, L. McKay, P. Shanks,
M. Wainman, Regional Councillor D. McLean, District Councillor
R. Reid.

Apologies: W. Duncan, S. Milton, M. Truscott.

Mrs. M. Morris tendered her resignation as Secretary as she had moved
from the district.

In accepting the resignation the Chairman thanked Mrs. Morris for the
work she had done for the Council.

Mrs. M. Wainman was elected as Secretary to deal with correspondence.
(Proposed H. Hughes, Seconded B. Innes.

H. Hughes was elected as Minutes Secretary (Proposed B. Innes,
Seconded M. Wainman).

Minutes of previous Meeting were adopted on the motion of P. Shanks
and H. Hern.

Business Arising from Minutes:

A) Kemnay Questionnaire - Deferred to next meeting.

B) Recreational facilities

1) General Purpose Pavilion for Kemnay Pleasure Park.

A plan of a pre-fabricated pavilion proposed for Huntly
Park was inspected and discussed. It was decided that a
separate committee of interested parties be formed to handle the
matter, the Community Council to be initially represented
by L. McKay.

2) Childrens Play Area - Kemnay Pleasure Park: The Chairman
reported that a voluntary squad including Councillors Innes,
McKay, Hern and Hughes had begun laying rubber padded slabs
provided by Gordon District Council to improve safety around
the childrens equipment.

3) Play Facilities - Alehousewells: Councillor Reid reported that
the G.D.C. had approved the provision of an all weather play
area adjacent to Membhill Park. Work to commence shortly.

4) Temporary erection of Play equipment at Alehousewells School:
Councillor McLean was asked to press for immediate erection
of the equipment currently in store, pending completion of
the school playing fields.

5) McCombie Crescent Area: Councillor Reid reported that the
provision of a childrens play area there was still under
consideration by G.D.C.

6) Former Bradley Homes land at Aquithie Road: It was confirmed
that Grampian Regional Council had acquired the land. The
Chairman reaffirmed the council's view that the area be
developed as an open space amenity area. Councillor McLean was
asked to ascertain G.R.C's intention regarding the land.

- C) Garioch Academy: The Chairman reported that the council's views had been passed to Inverurie Schools Council for consideration at their next meeting.

- E) Gordon District Structure Plan Meetings: A joint meeting of Kemnay C.C. and Cluny, Midmar and Monymusk C.C. will be held in Kemnay Public Hall on Thursday, 26th October at 7.30p.m.

New Business:

- F) Library Service - A request by the library service for a complete set of Community Council Minutes for local history purposes was agreed.
- G) Traffic in Bog Road: Result of survey not yet known.
- H) Constitution of Kemnay Community Council: This has been accepted by G.D.C. with one amendment regarding appointment of returning officers. These to be appointed by the "Community Council" and not the "Chief Executive of Gordon District Council". The amendment was agreed.
- I) Use of Vacant Houses by District Council: The G.D.C. had requested information on empty houses. The Chairman pointed out that Kemnay Old Schoolhouse owned by Grampian Region had been empty for two years. Use for a park-keeper was suggested.
- J) Review of Electoral Arrangements for Gordon District: The Secretary was instructed to write to G.D.C. that in view of the substantial increase in numbers of electors consideration should be given to creating additional wards in the district.

The Council agreed to an offer from Doctor Graham Young to speak at the next meeting on Medical Services in the village.

- L) Councillor Wainman said that complaints had been received of lack of facilities for dog exercising since the erection of a sign by G.D.C. prohibiting dogs in the Pleasure Park. It was decided to obtain a copy of the bye-laws governing the park before proceeding with the matter.
