

MINUTES OF MEETING OF KEMNAY COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 30TH  
APRIL 1992

1. Mr Wainman welcomed those present. The apologies were read.
2. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Proposed adoption: Mr Evans, seconded: Mr Marco. Passed no dissent.

3. Matters arising:-

(a) Kemnay Clean-Up Day - 16th May 1992. Mr Yates said he had been told by Mr Brown that everything was going ahead as planned.

4. Unfinished Business - Land in Bennachie View. Cllr Wainman said the Department will be sending out a questionnaire to the tenants in Paradise Road backing onto this land, asking for their opinions on the land. It is hoped to have the information back in time for the next Housing Committee meeting in May.

Lack of Road Name in Fraser Place - letter to be sent to Region asking for a new sign at the bottom end of Fraser Place.

5. Correspondence Received:- Letters from DSS benefits Agency; Kemnay Parish Church; Gordon District (enclosing cheque); Victim Support Scotland; Gordon District (Local Plan); Gordon District (Local Community Radio); Gordon District (responsible dog ownership); Kemnay Academy Community Education Department; The Cormorant Trust Fund; The Scottish Office Inquiry Reporters (Craigmyle Wood).

6. New Business.

(a) Provision of Hand Rails at Public Hall. It was reported that this had been taken up with Gordon District and the Social Services Department. Plans have been drawn up and approved. The District Council have been asked to put it into the Budget of the appropriate Department. Mr A Strang then presented his Petition which contained around 300 names.

(b) Cllr Wainman received a letter from the Director of Planning about the Kintore Bye-Pass. The date for a provisional presentation meeting to which Kemnay Community Council are invited, is set for Tuesday 26th May 1992. A bus will leave Gordon House at 6.15 p.m. to travel the route of the proposed bye-pass and also the route of Kintore Community Council's proposed changes. Mr Yates volunteered to attend on our behalf.

(c) Name and numbering of new housing development in Kemnay. The Developers have suggested Springfield Road. Mrs Milton was consulted

with regard to a possible historical connection. She had suggested Scotts Folds. After discussion it was agreed to ask for the adoption of this name.

(d) Mr Wainman mentioned various matters including Environmental Health re Dogs and Cats and Toxicara and the National Lottery.

7. District News. Concern was again expressed at the state of the site owned by Kemnay Taxis. Cllr Wainman said they were under a permanent Enforcement Notice. The Planning Department had given permission for one house to be built on the remainder of the site. Part of the permission was to erect a wall between the proposed new house and the present Taxi Business and also shrubs so it would be secluded. AGENDA ITEM - next meeting - licencing of taxis in Kemnay.

8. Regional News. In the absence of Cllr Hunter there was none.

9. Planning Applications. Five in all. In relation to an application by the owners of 3 and 21 Boat Croft to take over an amenity area, members to take a look before the next meeting. The nearby residents to be consulted. AGENDA ITEM - next meeting.

10. A.O.C.B.

(a) Mr Strang mentioned the difficulty of access experienced by the disabled, both to the Bank and the Cash Dispenser. Letter to be written to the Bank.

(b) Mr Yates mentioned local boys in cars speeding around the village and also hanging around outside the Chip Shop. Sgt Massie said that the Police are aware of the problem. Members of the public to get the registration numbers of offenders and telephone the police. Mr Wainman thanked Sgt Massie for his help.

11. There being no further business to discuss the meeting ended at 8.50 p.m. The next meeting will be on Thursday 28th May 1992.
